Program Overview

Today's health leaders balance multiple roles, multiple portfolios and make split second decisions.

Internationally recognized health leaders have come together to create Leadership in Public Health, a new cutting-edge one-year certificate course in health leadership that blends management practices with technical vitals, to provide an essential career edge to participants.

The course curriculum integrates experiences from their lives to illustrate theories and practices through hands on activities and a dedicated mentoring plan to enable future leaders to contribute positively and spearhead programmes to improve health of the population.

By the end of the course, you will have your own personal development plan to leap ahead in your career.

You will also have tools to enable you to strategize, make informed decisions and mentor your teams to take them forward with you.

Course Objectives

- Examine different practices in health to manage large programmes involving multiple stakeholders.

Who should take the course?

If you are a professional with background in healthcare, economics, social sciences, biostatistics, business, management, journalism, IT, life sciences, health, law, government organizations and

departments and non-government organizations, wishing to take on leadership positions in your career path, this course is right for you.

This course is for professionals with a desire to develop solutions for issues in public health in their countries or states.

Eligibility conditions

- Master's degree in relevant field.
- Three years of work experience in relevant areas.

Course format

The duration of the course is one year. The course involves two face to face sessions (February and September) at Manipal Academy of Higher Education, each session is for a week. Rest of the course will be delivered using online platform.



Key themes

- Public Health systems, operations and strategic leadership tools.
- Leadership and effective communication.
- Leadership in health systems policy and setting health agenda.
- Management skills in leadership.

Institutes involved

The Leadership in Public Health course is a collaborative effort by national and international public health and management leaders from Manipal Academy of Higher Education, (www.manipal.edu/mu) and the George Institute for Global Health (www.georgeinstitute.org.in), and selected mentors from University of Minnesota, USA and Maastricht University, The Netherlands.

Course assessment

- Successful defense of project work and submission of a personal development plan.
- 100% attendance in face to face session.
- Participation in online sessions.

Application process and deadlines

Online applications should be submitted by **20th December 2019**.

Shortlisted candidates will be intimated by **10th of January 2020 after an online interview (Skype)**.

Last date for payment of fees: **5th February, 2020**.

Course commences: **24th February 2020**.

Course fees

For candidates from India – INR 2,20,000

For candidates from other countries – USD 4,000

Scholarships for Indian national: Scholarships offered by the university is based on the need and document verification while admissions related decisions are based on completed application form; write-up on project; performance in the interview; recommendation letters and letter of support from the organization.

Scholarship process

1. The scholarship Form will be enabled only for those candidates who have been made a firm offer of Admission to Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE) after the Skype interview. Candidates will have 5 working days after they receive a Firm Offer of Admission to complete the scholarship Form. All relevant details and instructions will be emailed to the successful candidates.
2. Complete the scholarship form and send relevant documents before **16th January**.
3. The concerned authorities at MAHE will verify and assess the information provided by the candidate.
4. The Committee reviews each candidate's application and makes a decision. Candidate to ensure that all documents are uploaded. The Committee will not follow up for missing documents.
5. Candidate nominated for scholarship by the selection committee will get 50% fee waiver on tuition fee.





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
